


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Contents of the bag of fasteners:

Assembly instructions	1	M14 hex head locknut	10
M10x20 pan head screw	20	M10 hex head nut	40
M14x100 hex head screw	10	M10 washer	48
Eyebolt Ø14 length 100 with chain	2	Square drive bit 60	2
M10x60 hex head screw	8	M10 locknut	8
Towing bar eyebolt Ø14	2	10x70 Zn rectangular	2
Lynch pin Ø4	2	head bolt with nut	8
Roof bracket	4	Bolted clevis	4

IMPORTANT NOTE:

To avoid any risk of injury when using our hay racks for horses:

- 1. You are strongly advised to position the runners and roof arches at the highest level.
- 2. Use the towing protection (reference 1121143).
- 3. Use the roof protection (reference 1121135).



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
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
2 pallets.

IMPORTANT: From step 2, we recommend that you do not fully tighten the screws!





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6. Fitting the clevises

Fit the 4 clevises with the 8 10x70 rectangular head bolts with nuts

- + 8 M10 washers
- + 8 M10 locknuts







7. Assembling the panels

2 m x 2 m hay rack: 1 opening panel + 2 fixed panels.

Mount the fixed panels using M14x100 hex head screws in the 4 clevises.

For the opening panel:

Choose the direction of opening, left or right. Then mount the panel using the M14x100 hex head screws on the hinge side and using the eyebolts with chains on the other side.

NOTE: For the 3-head yoke gate, the direction of opening must be on the hinge on the handle side.





8. Fastening the runners

Raise the hay rack and fit the runners to the desired height (3 options), then secure them with M10x60 hex head screws.

IMPORTANT: Firmly tighten all of the screws from the previous assembly steps.


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9. Towing bar


To prevent harming the animal, you must remove the towing bar after transport.



10. Installing the roof brackets

On either side of the arch, add an M10 hex nut and an M10 washer.

Do not tighten.



11. Fastening the roof panels

Position the roof panels on the arches, adhering to the required overlap (2 overlapping corrugations; the central panel is above the two sides). Then position the metal straps perpendicularly and secure them using the roof brackets.

Tighten all of the brackets.
